SUBJECT: Notice of Instruction: Clarification to Notice of Instruction #: 022312-1-I-SWCBS: Older Americans Act (OAA) Program Income Reporting

The purpose of this notice is to provide clarification to Notice of Instruction #: 022312-1-I-SWCBS in regard to information required by the Administration on Aging as follows:

A. Program income is defined in 45 CFR Part 92.25 (b) as gross income received by the grantee or subgrantee directly generated by a grant-supported activity, or earned only as a result of the grant agreement during the grant period. This definition includes consumer contributions. Consumer contributions are collected and expended under the following terms:

- The Contractor assures compliance with Section 315 of the OAA as amended in 2006, in regard to consumer contributions;
- Consumer contributions are not to be used for matching;
- Consumer contributions are to be used only to expand services;
- Accumulated consumer contributions are to be used prior to requesting federal reimbursement; and
- Consumer contributions must be expended within the fiscal year earned.

B. The attached Receipt and Expenditure Report forms are revised in this notice as follows: program income is removed from Form 105aa; and instead, program income is documented as earned in Part A and expended in Part C on Forms 105as and 105ae. The Request for Payment Form 106a, is revised to include services, units, and rates.
