**SUBJECT:** Notice of Policy: Pseudo ID Numbers

The purpose of this policy is to provide new guidelines for creating pseudo ID numbers for clients whose Social Security numbers are unknown. **However, providers should continue to make every effort to obtain the correct Social Security number if possible.**

**BACKGROUND:** Pseudo Social Security numbers have been identified as an obstacle to reconciling the APS referrals in the CIRT system with the APS referrals in DCF's FAHIS system.

**Current CIRT Policy Guidelines:** "to create a pseudo ID, use the first letter of the client's first name, middle initial, and the first letter of the last name. **If the middle initial is not known, use the first two letters of the client's first name.** Then enter the six character date of birth MM/DD/YY. **If the DOB is not known, make one up.**"

**New Policy Guidelines:** "to create a pseudo client ID, use the client's initials from their name (first middle and last) for the first three characters. **If the middle initial is unknown then enter "X".** The last six characters are created by entering the client's six-digit date of birth MM/DD/YY. **Do not make up a DOB.** These guidelines should be used for all DOEA clients whose Social Security numbers are unknown.

This policy shall take effect on July 15, 2003.
