SUBJECT: Notice of Instruction: Aged and Disabled Adult Waiver Enrollment Halt

The purpose of this notice is to inform you that the Aged/Disabled Adult (ADA) Waiver is closed to additional enrollment as of the date of this notice. The Department monitors expenditure and projection data on an ongoing basis, and based on data through the month of December 2010, it is necessary to cease ADA enrollment to ensure that the program's legislative funding authority is not exceeded. The Department will continue to review spending and projection data, and will notify Area Agencies on Aging once the program is re-opened to new enrollment.

Enrollment of elders designated as Nursing Home Transition clients who are eligible for ADA services through nursing home transition proviso funding will continue as well as enrollment of elders referred for services by Adult Protective Services (APS). Additionally, this notice includes a halt on identification of Community Care for the Elderly enrollees who are Medicaid-Waiver probable.

Please provide Eunice Medina with a spreadsheet listing each client in your Planning and Service Area who is currently on the APPL for the ADA waiver. The list must also include the Medicaid eligibility status of each client as either 1) Medicaid application filed with the Department of Children and Families or 2) Medicaid application not filed with the Department of Children and Families. Please provide this spreadsheet no later than close of business Friday, January 21.

Clients whose applications have not yet been filed with the Department of Children and Families may not be enrolled in the ADA Waiver. Instead, these clients should be re-choice counseled or returned to the APPL.
