SUBJECT: Notice of Instruction: Nursing Home Transition Survey Scheduled

The purpose of this memo is to inform you that the Department of Elder Affairs Planning and Evaluation Unit will soon be conducting a random survey of elders who moved out of a nursing home back to the community.

The purpose of the survey is to learn about the experiences of elders who moved back to the community and how they are doing now. This will help us evaluate outcomes of elders who transitioned to the community.

The goal is to complete about 250 surveys statewide. Calls will be made from a list of 1,250 Nursing Home Transition clients drawn at random from the Client Information Registration and Tracking System (CIRTS) database. Letters will be sent to all potential respondents although not all who receive a letter will be called. The survey will begin about December 5, 2011.
